

**QUESTION ONE**

Juliette is an artist who has four new art works to frame. She has contacted a local Art Framer with the length of each painting to be framed. The dimension of the art works include painting 1 - fifty eight centimetres by twenty seven centimetres, painting 2 - one hundred and thirteen millimetres by two hundred and eighty six millimetres, painting 3 – one hundred and thirty eight centimetres by two hundred and eighty two centimetres, and painting 4 – four hundred and eighty six centimetres by three hundred and sixteen centimetres. Juliette has selected to frame all four painting with the with the same style of wood.
